FIBER TO THE HOME PROJECT UPDATE

As we end 2023, it's a time for reflection on the past year and a look ahead to all the potential that 2024 holds. We are extremely excited by our community's growth and transformation throughout the year, driven by our cooperative's unwavering commitment to delivering reliable and affordable high-speed internet in collaboration with Conexon Connect.

By now, you know the numerous ways fiber technology can revolutionize our daily lives, offering opportunities for real-time connection for personal and professional benefits, including online learning, efficient remote work, convenient telemedicine, and staying in contact with loved ones.

I'm pleased to share with you that throughout 2023, Sac Osage Electric, in collaboration with Conexon Connect, has made great progress in bringing fiber broadband service to our unserved and underserved communities and will continue that progress throughout our territory. In the fall, we saw our 3,400th member connected to the Connect, powered by Sac Osage Electric, network!

In addition to this big milestone, this community-transforming project date has had a mountain of accomplishments:

- We will have built over 2,000 miles of fiber line by the end of the year.
- We expect to connect approximately 3,900 members before the publication of this issue.
- We connect about 50 members per week.
- Service is now available to homes and businesses throughout our territory encompassing portions of Henry, St. Clair, Vernon, Barton, Cedar, Dade, Benton, Hickory, and Polk counties.

- We will complete construction in Dadeville in 1Q 2024.
- Our cooperative's fiber build is set to be complete by end of 2024, meaning every Sac Osage Electric member will have access to worldclass internet service right here in their own service territory this year.

As we reflect on these accomplishments, we are excited about the journey ahead and the continued growth of our cooperative. Our members are an integral part of this journey, and our dedication to offering high-speed internet services through Connect, powered by Sac Osage Electric, is solely driven by the aim to meet your needs. We are working diligently to ensure that all our members have access to faster, more reliable, and more affordable fiber technology as quickly as possible.

Fiber-fast internet packages start as low as \$49.95 a month for speeds of up to 100 Mbps. Multi-Gigabit speed is also available for our power users for \$79.95 per month for 1 Gig or \$99.95 for 2 Gig service. HD-quality voice service is also available starting at \$29.95 per month, and Conexon Connect has partnered with DIRECTV to offer more options to "cut the cord" on cable with streaming service packages to fit any budget.
