



STORM SEASON IS UPON US

As spring rapidly approaches, it also brings the potential for severe storms and dangerous weather conditions. It's crucial to have an emergency safety kit ready to ensure your family's safety. Here are some essential items to include in your kit:

- Bottled water
- Nonperishable food items
- Portable phone charger
- Flashlights
- Extra batteries
- Can opener
- First-aid supplies
- · Hand sanitizer
- · Prescription medications
- Pain relievers
- Warm clothing and blankets
- Battery-operated radio
- Toys, books, and games for entertainment

As always, staying away from downed power lines is crucial for your safety and the safety of others.

Immediately report the hazard to your local utility company or emergency services, providing them with the exact location to ensure a swift response. Your prompt action can

prevent accidents and ensure the safety of your community.

REQUEST FOR E-MAIL BILLINGS/NOTICES AND RELEASE (Paperless Billing)

The undersigned member of Sac Osage Electric Cooperative, Inc. (the "Cooperative") hereby requests that the Cooperative only submit to the undersigned electronically by e-mail all billings, invoices and other billing and disconnection notices and further requests that the Cooperative no longer mail physical bills, invoices or other written notices (including service termination and disconnection notices) to the undersigned.

In order for the Cooperative to honor this request, the undersigned does further agree and does hereby release the Cooperative, its officers, directors, employees and agents from all claims, demands, suits and/or liabilities arising out of any failure by the undersigned to receive monthly billings and other notices by United States Mail, and Member does further understand that failure to timely pay any billing or other notice sent to the undersigned by the Cooperative electronically shall have the same consequences as far as termination and disconnection of service as if the billing or other notice had been sent to the undersigned by U.S. Mail.
