FOUR-PART RATE DESIGN DISCUSSION

Over the past several months we have been discussing the new fourpart rate design scheduled to begin April 1, 2019. This new rate is designed to be as revenue neutral as possible; however, some members may see an increase while others a decrease in their monthly bill. By simply minimizing usage between the hours of 6 AM – 9 AM and 4 PM - 7 PM, members may see a reduction in their monthly bill. This new rate design has the potential for helping both Sac Osage Electric and its members reduce their power bill.
